*The Transition Plan included in the proposed bylaws states the following regarding the ongoing existence of AAPG's membership groups:

- No later than 30 days following the adoption of these Bylaws, the Stakeholder Relations Director, Member Services Director, and Academic Relations Director shall meet with each of the Association membership groups existing prior to adoption of these Bylaws – e.g., Women's Network, Young Professionals Network, Corporate Advisory Board – to discuss the members' interest in the group's continuation and their preferences for involvement in a Membership Directorate.
- The Directors shall report the information gathered from their meetings with their respective membership groups to the Board. No later than 45 days following the adoption of these Bylaws, the Board shall notify each membership group of the Membership Directorate to which they belong.
- All membership groups existing prior to adoption of these Bylaws that express an interest in continuing to exist may do so.
